Initiative to transform the world's longest sea dike into a tourist attraction

- **The Sea Dike Development Project is in full swing to promote the world's longest sea dike as a major international tourist attraction.**
 - The Sea Dike Development Project is aimed at utilizing land created by the construction of the Saemangeum sea dike and developing an international tourist attraction. The Ministry for Food, Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries is in charge of the Project, and the Korea Rural Community Corporation has been commissioned to carry out the Project.
- **To this date, the Sea Dike Development Project has attracted investments of over \$3.1 billion from the private sector, while other projects, like the Sinsido Tourist Facilities Development Project and the Megaresort Development Project, are being carried out to provide tourist and convenience facilities.**
 - In 2010, Saemangeum Consortium was designated as a private developer for the Sinsido Tourist Facilities Development Project, and a business agreement for the Megaresort Development Project will be concluded by March 2011 with the selected bidder.

- **The government will secure project funds of \$88 million for establishing public convenience facilities that will help stimulate private investment. The government will also prepare a basic plan by the end of this year to set the direction of public-sector development in the Sea Dike Development Project.**

Creation of a major landmark in Saemangeum

- **Recently, the Ministry of Land, Transport and Maritime Affairs completed research on setting up a new symbol that represents Saemangeum's future vision, "The City of Neo Civitas, Ariul."**
- **The research led to the formulation of action plans for the creation of a new landmark including bidding methods and guidelines to select developers.**
- **The Saemangeum landmark will be designed with the theme of "creating a prosperous future". Together with the world's longest sea dike, the landmark will be promoted to serve as the brand of Saemangeum, creating new cultural assets along the way.**

Preparation for an era of 10 million tourists at Saemangeum!

■ **Saemangeum Gunsan Free Economic Zone Authority has started to develop in earnest the Saemangeum tourism complex, where accommodations, a marina, and a theme park for tourists will be formed.**

- In particular, the authority plans to hold a public bid to select a master developer during the first quarter of this year for the development of the tourist complex and other areas.
- The Saemangeum tourist complex will be developed as the world's best waterfront tourism and leisure complex by making good use of the surrounding natural and artificial environment including the world's longest sea dike; Gogunsan Archipelago, consisting of more than 60 small and large islands; and Byeonsanbando National Park, boasting a picturesque natural landscape.

■ **Meanwhile, the Gateway Project, a lead project to reclaim an area of 1km² within the complex, has accomplished reclamation by 35% and is expected to complete it by September this year.**

- This site will play the role of gateway for Saemangeum's tourism industry by offering public and convenience facilities including parking lots for visitors in a short term, and by providing the theme park, marina villages, and pension-style villas to guests in a longer term

■ **On December 30, 2010, the Gunsan Regional Maritime Affairs and Port Office began environmental impact assessment and basic research on the construction of a breakwater to build a port, thus setting in motion the new port development.**

- The planned port is to be constructed off the waterfront of Sea Dike No. 2. It is Korea's first attempt to develop an artificial port island and a total project cost of over \$2.2 billion will be invested in the construction of a breakwater and a wharf, whose lengths are 3.8km and 4.1km, respectively, and a site, whose area amounts to 4,880km².

■ **The government intends to attract about \$230 million of private capital in order to build the wharf on the island. The new port, which will be developed as an economic hub for a new era of the West Coast to fulfill the functions of logistics, leisure, and tourism, is predicted to provide both domestic and foreign investors with good opportunities for SOC investment.**
